OUR APPROACH

At MBS, we focus on providing quality education to low-income rural families through a social enterprise model that ensures responsibility and sustainability. This is achieved by charging modest fees to able students supplemented by donations and scholarships for needy students. The goal is to have a self-sustaining non-profit social enterprise with any profits ploughed back to improving the institution and providing education scholarships up to university level for benefiting students. Enrollment is assessed based on academic and co-curricular activities competencies and neediness ensuring equal opportunities for different abled students.

Further, we work with the neighbouring communities and surrounding schools to provide services such as digital learning and after school programs.

We also run a school feeding program for all students, which ensures that students from needy backgrounds are able to focus on learning.

We have continued to attract qualified and experienced teachers who are committed to our mission. We recruited additional science and language teachers to handle Junior school.
